

2020 presented the world with an unprecedented global pandemic that created uncertainty and delays in all industries. Staying on top of the current health and safety protocols to protect students, staff, contractors, and the public were a top priority and extremely challenging to navigate. These obstacles were difficult, but ACUSD was able to accomplish important milestones in the DVES Modernization Bond Project.

The first quarter of 2020 was a very busy time for the architects who were creating, updating and getting approval of site designs, drawings, and timelines. When spring arrived so did COVID-19. ACUSD had to get creative with bid walks and planning meetings in order to move forward with the Phase I bid and ensure safety. ACUSD was able to work through the Phase I bidding process and open the bid on April 30, 2020.

The initial Phase I plan included electrical upgrades, installation of a safety fence, and the relocation of building F and converting it into a modern Information Technology (IT) office to support student learning in the digital age. It was determined, due to the high cost of asbestos mitigation, that it would be more cost effective to move the electrical upgrades to Phase II to coincide with the construction occurring at that time. The remaining items of the Phase I project were completed in December 2020.

Illustrated below is a timeline of 2020 milestones, summary of expenditures, and pictures of the building F (new IT) relocation.








Phase II / Building A Modernization Plans Approved by DSA
